VENUE: THE SPORTS AND ENTERTAINMENT HALL "POD DEBOWCEM"

IN 26 KARBOWA STREET, BIELSKO-BIAŁA, POLAND

RULES:

All members of WKF are admitted to participate. Tournament will be conducted according to the current WKF Competition Rules and Polish Karate Union regulations described in the Bulletin. The date of birth determinate about the proper age category. Competitors can participate in two age categories (except Juniors in Seniors Kumite). Participation in two weight categories as part of one age group is forbidden

KATA:

- In Kata for children U8 and 8 years old it is allowed to repeat one Kata;
- In Kata for children 9,10,11 years old minimum two different Kata have to be done alternatively;
- In Kata U14 minimum three different kata have to be done alternatively;
- In Kata Cadets Masters WKF Competition Rules;
- In Kata it is allowed to participate in two age categories.

Duration of the KUMITE bout is:

- Senior Male and Female categories: 3 minutes effective time
- Under 21 Male and Female categories: 2 minutes effective time
- Masters Male and Female categories: 2 minutes effective time
- Cadet and Junior Male and Female categories: 2 minutes effective time
- U12 and U14 Male and Female categories: 1.5 minutes effective time
- U10 Male and Female categories: 1 minute effective time
- It is allowed to participate in two age categories (except Juniors in Seniors).
- For competitors <14 years of age no contact to the head, face or neck is allowed with hand or leg techniques.

PROTECTIVE EQUIPMENT

Please be informed that protective equipment used during the POLISH OPEN does not need to have WKF homologation. However, it should be designed for karate and conform to the WKF model standards. Kumite and Kata karategis with the brand name embroidered on the shoulders in RED or BLUE are NOT MANDATORY!

ENTRY FEE:

40 EUR – one entry in category: U8, U10, U12, U14, Cadets, Juniors 50 EUR – one entry in category: U21, Seniors, Masters

Each entry goes into the waiting list and only after receiving online payment or by bank transfer it will be accepted. To speed up the process of online registration we ask to send the confirmation of the bank transfer by email: atemi.konrad@gmail.com – There is no refund policy on paid entries!

CONDITIONS OF PARTICIPATION:

The competition is open for Polish (members of POLISH KARATE UNION) and foreign clubs. Each contestant should have: identity card with a photo, competitors license, a doctor's permission to take part in the competition and full insurance coverage for all eventualities. All of these documents should be prepared for possible control during the registration.



AWARDS:

Competitors who are first in the individual contests will receive memorial cups, medals and diplomas. For 2nd and 3rd places they will receive memorial medals and diplomas.

REGISTRATION:

All competitors, referees, coaches and officials must register online using the online system at www.sportdata.org/karate. No onsite registration will be accepted. In case of any questions concerning the online registration please directly contact the sportdata software team via the email address: atemi.konrad@gmail.com.



Clubs / teams / federations are responsible for the quality of the entered registration data. Deadline of making any changes in entries is **9.10.2024**. When the limit of entries is reached, the online registration will be closed. If changes are required during official registration session because of incorrect data, **a fee of 20 EUR** is charged for each change. Deleting the entry during the official registration session is charged 100% of the entry fee.

There will not be possibility of making any changes in the day of the contest except deleting the entry of the competitor. Deleting the entry of the competitor in the day of the competitions means that you are still obliged to pay the full entry fee.

The official registration session will take place at the competition office (Hala pod Dębowcem) on Friday, October 18, from 10:00 am to 6:00 pm.

Please note that weigh-in is mandatory for all kumite categories!

- Weigh-in for athletes competing on Saturday will take place on Friday at the venue (Hala pod Dębowcem) from 10:00 am to 6 pm.
- Weigh-in for athletes competing on Sunday will take place on Saturday at the venue (Hala pod Dębowcem) from 9 am to 8 pm.
- Additional weigh-in session will be held on Sunday at the venue (Hala pod Dębowcem) from 9 am to 11 am.

Accreditations for competitors and coaches will be issued also on the day of competition (for those who will not attend the official registration session on Friday) from 07:00 to 18:00.

At registration session, accreditation cards will be issued with the participants main data, a photograph and information about registered categories. The accreditation card must be worn at all times during the event. Fast line to pick up accreditations will be available for those who paid the entry fee by bank transfer.



OTHER:

All controversial matters will be solved by the Chief Referee of the competition in agreement with the organizer. The organizer isn't responsible for lost items. Heads of teams are responsible for competitors' behaviour or eventual damages made by them.

Only athletes and coaches can stay in the field of play during the tournament. Officials, heads of delegations and audience have to stay in the spectators area. Press accreditation can only be given to professional journalists working for a media and having proof of their credentials. If a Refereeing procedure appears to contravene the rules, the Competitor's Coach or its official representative are the only ones allowed to make a protest. The complainant must deposit a Protest Fee of 200 EUR.

The exhibition and sale of goods is allowed on the conditions of Organizer. The professional catering service will be provided in the competition area by the Restaurant Wirtuozeria. As regards that the specific items are not expressly foreseen in the present bulletin reference is to be made to the general rules and guidelines contained in WKF Regulations and the provisions of the Civil Code.


